Nature High Summer Camp Participant Expectations

A \$100.00 registration fee will be due upon acceptance to the camp (some scholarships may be available).

Activities are scheduled daily from 7 AM to 10 PM.

Participation is required in ALL scheduled camp activities.

Each participant will be assigned, and will be responsible to a group leader.

No participant may leave the camp area during the duration of the camp without permission of the Camp Director.

Any participant driving their own vehicle to the camp must turn in all the keys to the Camp Director. Keys will be returned at the end of camp.

Be friendly and respectful of other personnel who will be present at camp.

Disrespectful actions toward counselors, staff and/or other participants will not be tolerated.

Obscene and foul language is prohibited.

Report illnesses, injuries, etc. to camp staff immediately.

Each participant is responsible for all equipment used throughout the week. Damaged equipment and/or facilities will be paid for by the involved participant(s). Cards and other table games are permissible in the dorms (during free time); however any form of gambling is prohibited.

All portable radios, MP3 players, Walkman, IPODs, CD players or other forms of "personal music systems" are to be left home. If found, they will be confiscated until the conclusion of camp.

All student cell phones will be turned off during camp and turned in if necessary. A camp cell phone will be available for use.

All tobacco (chew, snuff, cigarettes, etc.) and alcoholic products are prohibited. All prescription medication must be accompanied with BOTH a doctor's note and parental approval. These must be given to the Camp Director at the beginning of camp. The Camp Director will have final say in any dispute or accusation.

Violation of any of the above expectations can serve as grounds for dismissal from the Camp at the student's or parent's expense.
